All existing Union regulatory, budgetary, supervisory, judiciary and enforcement instruments and structures will apply, including the competence of the Court of Justice of the European Union.


• The United Kingdom will be a third country as of 30 March 2019. It will, therefore, no longer be represented in Union institutions, agencies, bodies and offices.

• The transition period needs to be clearly defined and precisely limited in time. It should not last beyond 31 December 2020. Consequently, the provisions on citizens' rights in the Withdrawal Agreement should apply as of the end of the transition period.

4. Legislative Context

4.1 The PMR 2014 will revoke and replace the MPR 2003. They will also revoke the Regulations and provisions of the other pieces of legislation that amended the MPR 2003. Some of the provisions contained in the MPR 2003 are now EU provisions contained in EU FIC and, in order to comply with EU law, will not be carried forward in the PMR 2014; other provisions in the MPR 2003 will be carried forward into the PMR 2014. In accordance with the Government's sunsetting policy, the PMR 2014 will cease to have effect on 13th December 2021 unless a further Statutory Instrument is made to continue them.]
